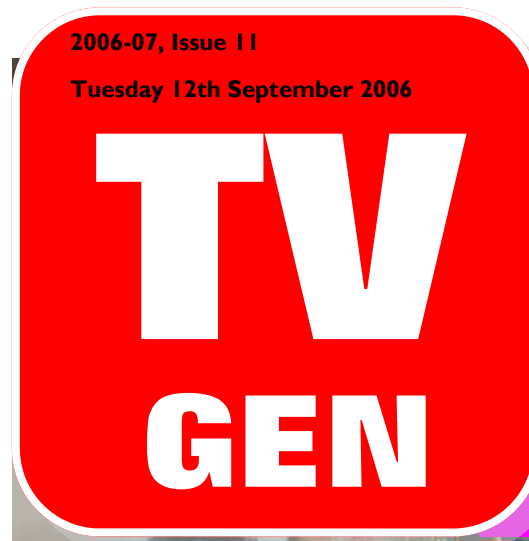

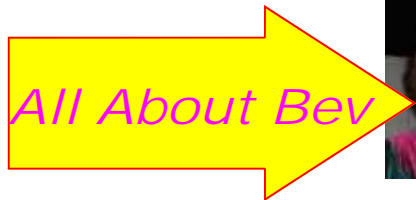

ROTARY YOUTH PROGRAM OF ENRICHMENT

Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment (RYPEN) is aimed for that large group of both boys and girls, aged 14 to 16 years, who have shown some qualities of decency, courage, persistence, sincerity and application in everyday life, which deserve further development.

The principle aim is to communicate to young people a series of ideas, problems and social experiences which will assist them in forming their own values and moral standards and to broaden their horizons culturally, socially and academically.

The week-long camp covers a range of topics, including: Communication; Tolerance; Drugs and Alcohol; Police, the Law and You; Physical Fitness; Job Seeking; Morals and Ethics and Where Religion is part of that element of life; and Social Skills.



The candidates selected are young people who satisfy the following criteria:

- Will benefit from the learning experience
- Not necessarily the highest achievers or outstanding youth leaders of the locality.
- Have potential to progress to a leadership role with added confidence and training.
