Her leadership has initiated strong growth of the clubs within the association & continuous improvement in the facilities available to players & their families at Murrumbeena's Duncan MacKinnon Reserve. Her lobbying resulted in an upgrade of the Duncan MacKinnon sports complex with resurfaced netball courts, new seating for spectators & shade structures.

She instigated Netball Victoria funding for an in-schools' programme at four primary Special Schools, namely Katandra, Monash, Port Philip & Ashwood Special Schools where weekly netball classes are held for children with mild intellectual disabilities. She is one of the regular coaches at Katandra.

Marg does all this with a quiet determination. She is also the primary carer of her husband who has cancer. She has a student daughter, still at home, & older twin sons. Her commitment to her husband & children is shared with a desire to improve life for others.

Don't forget this Saturday is our club Trivia Night at Caulfield Park Bowling Club at 8pm.

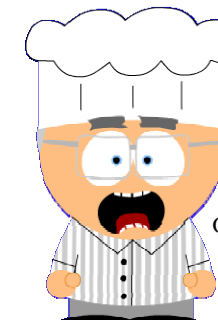
