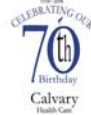

The Business Breakfast is our signature event and we are more than happy to have suggestions of who will be our business speaker.

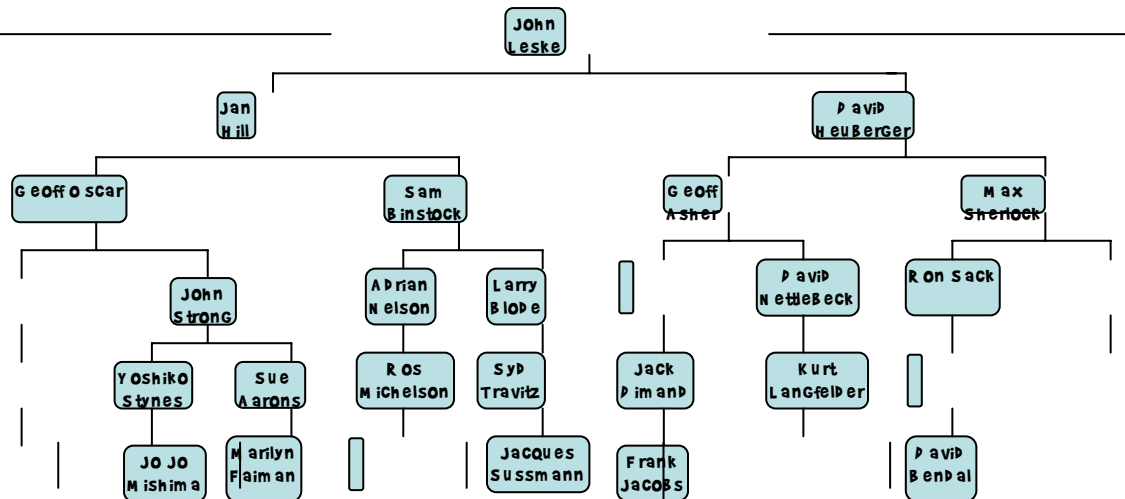
