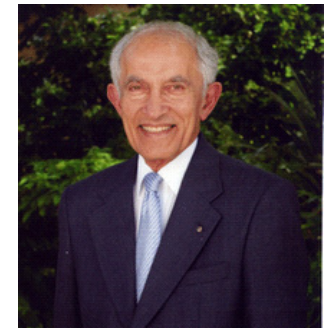
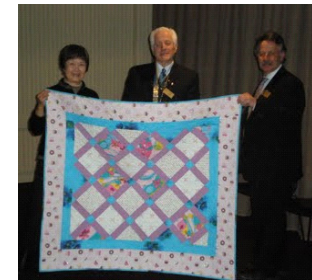
Jan Hill and Rotary
