## District 9800 Leads the World - Another Peace Fellowship Success

The Trustees of the Rotary Foundation have awarded one of 50 Rotary World Peace Fellowships to take a Masters degree in Peace and Conflict studies to Jessica Butcher who was nominated by RC Melbourne. She will study at the University of North Carolina. Jessica is the 14th person successfully nominated by D9800 in the 10 years of the program and we are the only District in the world to have been successful in every year of the program.

Jessica is employed by the Uniting Church being committed to interfaith work between Christians and Muslims working both in Australia and Indonesia and has extended her activities to bringing Indigenous and other Australians together, particularly in northern Australia.

Natasha Holt, nominated by RC Gisborne, has been selected as first reserve for Duke University. Natasha held an Australian Youth Ambassadors Award in China working on HIV/AIDS prevention there. Since her return she has been working on child protection particularly as it relates to Child Sex Trafficking and Slavery focusing on the Asia/Pacific region.

Sophie Brown, nominated by RC Melbourne has been selected as 3rd reserve for Duke University. Sophie has been working in Afghanistan having worked for The World Bank, The Economist magazine and International Monetary Fund. She is helping build basic administrative infrastructure in economic ministries in Afghanistan and is now seconded to helping flood recovery in Pakistan.

With only 4 Australians being selected this year plus 3 being reserves, the District continues to perform well above its weight. Last year, 7 Australians were selected of whom 4 were from D9800.

In addition to the Masters Program, 50 Fellowships were available for the 3 month Certificate Program at Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok. However, of the 46 applicants only 32 met the selection criteria. So we need to look for mid career people working in the field with 5 or more years relevant experience – the vacancies are there for the next round. Our Fellows who were on the recent July program speak glowingly of it. Extracts of Samantha Hardy's report are in a separate article in Foundation News.
