Rotary busier than ever by Parkes Champion Post

Parkes Rotary Club continues to be very active in the community and the past six weeks have been no exception.

The Westlime Charity Golf Day was a resounding success with golfers praising the altered format which allowed a later starting time and an earlier finish making the day much more pleasant for everyone.

The book buyers prize of a five day holiday courtesy of the Meridian, Alexandra Headland, on Queensland's Sunshine Coast was won by Michelle Stewart of Parkes.

Some of the money raised on the day will be donated to the Rotary District Disaster Appeal for the floods in Yenda and to the SES for Youth Week activities in Parkes.

The Golf Club will also benefit this year.

Parkes Rotary has also just completed the Rotary Young Driver Awareness (RYDA) program over two days at the showground.

About 300 Year 11 students from Parkes, Forbes, Peak Hill, Trundle, Condobolin and West Wyalong took part in the program which gives pre-licence youths a great perspective on what they will be facing through the Learner Driver period.

This program is supported by the schools, Parkes Shire Council, Parkes Police and this year, the Midstate Motorcycle Club donated \$700 to assist in the cost of transport of pupils to Parkes.

Each participant is sponsored either by their local Rotary Club and/ or their employer.

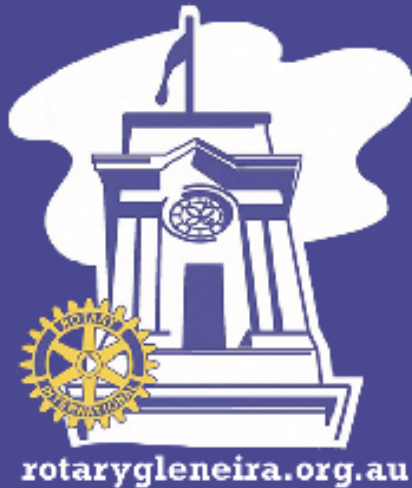
This is very busy week for Rotarians as they are cooking and serving all of the meals for the participants.
