Rotary International India Extends Helping Hand to Pakistan

A new report has unfolded that India is being warned by Bill Gates not to be satisfied and happy with its success in eradication of the paralyzing virus Polio from the country.

As per the findings, the philanthropist, who had come for three days to India, had a meeting with the Rotary International India, the polio drive partner. The meeting was aimed at discussing the measures and ways to further continue the anti-polio drive, wherein he gave such warnings.

While neighbouring country Pakistan has still been failing to fight the evil, the rotary has also announced that any kind of help needed would be provided by it to Pakistan.

"If need be, we will be ready to offer assistance to polio stricken victims of Pakistan offering them polio corrective surgeries in India or in Pakistan through our network", Dr. Rajendra K Saboo, Rotary's past president affirmed.
