## YOUTH OF THE YEAR WINNER

### Congratulations to Callum Lloyd, 2013 Youth of the Year!

Callum Lloyd is a Year 10 student at local McKinnon Secondary College. He has a strong connection within the local community, especially the college community - Callum has been actively involved in helping others less fortunate than himself.

Whether at school or involved in personal pursuits, he strives to do his very best. In year 7, he received a student manager's excellence award which was awarded for achieving excellent results and community service. In Year 9, Callum was the recipient of the Thistlelonians Award, again for outstanding commitment to the college, in particular involvement in the organization of the annual school charity fundraiser, the 24/7 Relay Challenge. He also travelled to Canberra to represent his school at the National Cyber Safety Summit.

This year Callum was the main organiser of the event. The 24/7 Relay Challenge provided him with many strong links to the wider McKinnon community. He liaised closely with students, staff and parents of the college. The purpose of this event is for students to organise themselves

into teams of seven and run in shifts around the college's oval for twenty four hours, raising money for charity. This year the event supported State Schools Relief. In 2011, they raised \$25,000 for Beyond Blue and last year raised \$43,000 for Zaidee's Rainbow Foundation in support of organ and tissue donation. He had to organise sponsorship, promotion and advertising. Callum addressed meetings with students to enlist their interest and then entered all their details. He also coordinated the job roster for the 24 hour period - this included various jobs such as breakfast and dinner service, food and drink stall, jumping castle supervision, and kitchen clean up.

As winner of the Youth of the Year Award, the Rotary Club of Glen Eira donates \$400 to Callum's charity of choice and additional \$400 to his school in the form of a scholarship. Callum's chosen charity is States School Relief.

## ROTARY PROJECT OF THE WEEK

### Camp Getaway

The Camp at Axedale was created as an initiative of the Rotary Club of Bendigo who saw the need for a youth camp in the Bendigo Region. The camp was initially opened in 1948 with the plan to provide recreational facilities for the needy children following the 2nd World War, the first guests were however a party of Young Farmers. By 1963 over 1,600 young people were using the camp each year.

In 2013, the camp has undergone a number of changes thanks to Rotarians and volunteers from the District 9800 which stretches from metropolitan Melbourne to the Murray at Echuca. Camp Getaway now includes modern dormitory style accommodation, a number of 2 bedroom units along with the a Kitchen, Dining Room, Lounge and Games Room.
