

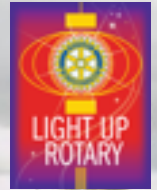

### Better Hearing

The Rotary Clubs of Toorak and Melbourne have joined together with Better Hearing Australia to encourage people to 'recycle' their old hearing aids. Australian hearing aid company Blamey Saunders Hears, the company behind the Bionic Ear & led by audiologist and scientist Dr Elaine Saunders (who will be guest speaker at our club next month), collects and assesses the donated hearing aids and refurbishes them for free, before passing them onto Better Hearing.

The Rotary Clubs are liaising with local council to promote the scheme and with pharmacists to provide additional drop-off points.
