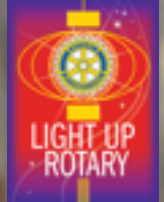

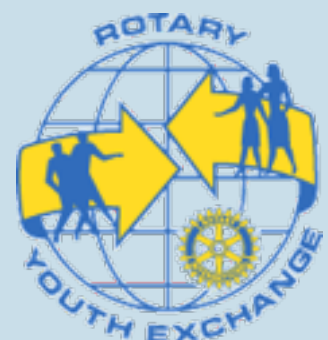


ROTARY PROJECT OF THE WEEK
