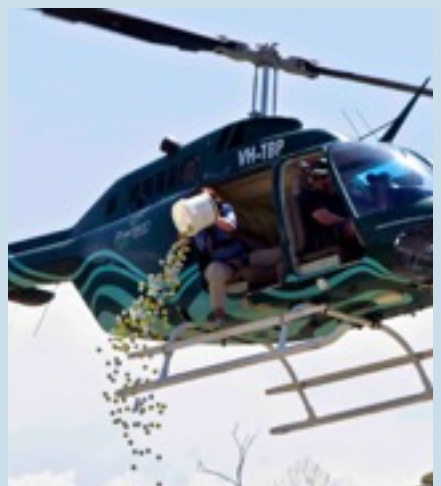
Golf Ball Drop
